### Red carpet not red tape

We continue to call on Minister Reilly and the HSE to increase the supports for our 300 families nationwide. As our nurses Sinead Moran and Caroline Thomas said (again!) at the Joint Oireachtas Committee for Health and Children recently, "the HSE should be rolling out the red carpet, not the red tape for our families, particularly for medical cards."

As we look to 2014, the ring fencing of a national paediatric homecare budget makes sense financially, medically and morally. We have a model at Jack & Jill that works in terms of quality and cost effectiveness, where the money really does follow the patient and has kept 1,700 children at home since 1997. Let that be the Pilot and a New Year's resolution for the HSE.

We start 2014 with €2.7 million to raise and thank you for your continued support. Watch out for "Up the Hill for Jack & Jill", prompted by John O'Sullivan in Kenmare, where families and friends are asked to host their own local Up the Hill for Jack & Jill, raising €16 per person, to fund 1 hour of home nursing care for a sick child in your community. Every little helps!


### Recycling—Schools

### **Ashgrove Auction**




An Antiques Roadshow
