Medical Cards Crisis



Like many of you, I watched in horror but not surprise, as Annette Kinne and Declan Coyle from Bray poured their hearts out to Brendan O'Connor on RTE's Saturday Night Show, exposing how their son Alex has had his medical card axed by the HSE. Into studio they brought with them just one week's supply of medical equipment for Alex. A cocktail of syringes, feeding pumps, nappies, medication and, with dignity and

pride, talked about their daily routine caring for Alex around the clock. It brought back memories of my own family's experience caring for our son Jack Irwin at home until he passed away in December 1997. Fast forward to May 2014 and I'm so disheartened that we are still in this dark place where parents have to fight for every little thing.

The real shame however is that Alex's story is not isolated. Parents around the country are being strangled by the red tape around medical cards. Asked to jump through hoops in terms of the information requests and none of it medical related, all financial. Embarrassed to ask the doctor for yet another letter of support. Exhausted. Being tortured into submission by the HSE – that's what it feels like. I know. I've been there. So have many of our readers. And our Jack & Jill nurses hear the stories every day.

What's more, the 'lucky' ones who do get the medical card, get temporary 6 or 12 month medical cards. Living in dread of the whole form filling torture to begin again. Parents are worried out of their mind. Many afraid to speak out in case they lose what little they have.

Meanwhile, there's not a parent in the Country who wants a free GP card for their youngster, while children like Alex are refused medical cards.

Young Alex Kinne Coyle may not have a voice, but he, like hundreds of other children, has feelings; he has rights and he deserves better. It's time to end this medical card nightmare, once and for all. Our call to action is simple to the Minister for Health, wider Government and to all the hopeful candidates for local and European election:

Review and redesign this system of discretionary medical cards. Recognise the child in his or her own right. The system is broken and we need you to fix it now.

- Listen & help co-ordinate families' wishes.
- Daily review of child and family's needs.
- 24-hour crisis care & telephone contact.
- Communicate and liaise with appropriate agencies.
- We facilitate Irish Hospice Foundation (IHF) and HSE funding for additional nursing care at home.
- Offer bereavement support and liaise with expert counsellors.
