Meeting us halfway with HSE funding

We are meeting Minister John Moloney on the 30th September regarding the HSE review of its disability budget and on our own level of HSE funding with regard to increasing it from 19% to 50%. We need to rally as many families and friends as possible to contact their local TDs before 30th September to support this campaign. - See website for contact details. You should explain your own connection with Jack & Jill and the fact that we support more babies than ever at 320 nationwide but our donations are down for the past two years and we really need the HSE to meet us halfway on funding as soon as possible.

We are also in close consultation with the HSE regarding the 81 families we support today with children over 4 years of age and I want to assure all those involved that we are monitoring this situation closely with the help of our nurses. Ideally, we want to extend our service from 4 to 6 year olds but before that can happen we need an increase in HSE funding before the end of the year.

Kiwi mobile phone campaign based on Jack & Jill model wins top award

The Starship Foundationøs Childrenøs Hospital in Auckland, New Zealand has won the Prime Ministerøs Supreme Award for its mobile phone recycling campaign which is based on the model used by the Jack & Jill here in Ireland. Jonathan Irwin, CEO and Founder of Jack & Jill was instrumental in establishing this campaign in 2009 which uses Jack & Jilløs Irish recycling partner Folamh.

New Zealanders donate their old mobiles, which are recycled through Folamh, to raise money specifically for the aircraft used by Starship Childrenøs Hospital to bring sick children to hospital, with over NZ \$750,000 raised already.

For every international link like this, Jack & Jill gets a commission fee.


Mavo


