€130,000 'hot money' we had to refund

In the last two months we have received and refunded over €130,000 via credit card donations which have been scammed from private credit cards, with individual amounts ranging from 2 cents up to €3,000, with the large majority under €5. It was the cent amounts and random digit names that alerted us to this scam, the victims being those who've had their card details stolen, the criminals using our website to test the card details before moving onto bigger transactions or selling on the details. This 'hot money' has taken 2 weeks of admin time to sort it out.

It was our duty to alert other charities, and we know of 3 other Irish charities affected, and to remind the public to check their statements for small 'tester' amounts. Most importantly, we are trying to convince the banks, who are desperate for good PR, to drop their charges to Jack & Jill, amounting to around €10,000 due to this scam. So if you have influence with our banking friends please use it.

I want to thank everyone for your wonderful messages of support which cushioned me and kept me going through my cancer surgery in May. As the song goes, 'what doesn't kill you makes you stronger' and I'm back in the office now, feeling strong and raring to go.

Sure, our challenge of raising €2.7 million annually is a big one. Having 300 children under our wing, depending on vital funding and nursing support, is a heavy responsibility. Dancing the usual tango with the HSE for funding is exhausting and makes me dizzy sometimes. The carpet to Leinster House is worn out as we lobby hard. So why does it feel so good to be back at my desk filling my diary?

It's simple - our home nursing care model works. It's fast, local, national, the children do better at home, the parents get a break, it costs nine times less than hospital care and shows Minister Reilly's money following the patient theory in practice. I challenge anyone to find a more dedicated or qualified team of nurses than our powerhouse at Jack & Jill. Our corporate partners are friends as well as fundraisers. Our schools and clubs stick with us through thick and thin and the 1,600 families we've supported since 1997 are our inspiration. Their stories and fundraising efforts keep us going.

For me, giving a voice to the children under our care and their exhausted families is second nature and I have a big voice. Fundraising by telling their story, which is my story too, is not a chore but a gift. So, it's good to be back and I want to thank you for your continued support.

Sam's lunch


